

## 3 Day Itinerary : **FANTASTIC MASAI MARA - SAFARI PLANE FROM THE COAST**

**Masai Mara** is the most famous safari park in Kenya and possibly in the entire African continent. It is not very big, in fact the park extends for only 320 sq km, between the grassy plains of the Serengeti and the evocative forests of acacia trees which are populated by an infinite number of monkeys. Everyone should have the possibility of setting foot in the Masai Mara to experience the following: hills covered with soft grass, the Mara river full of hippos and a variety of wildlife. We will provide you with the traditional safari atmosphere, a landscape that you've only ever seen in photos or on television. The reserve opened in 1961, is located west of the Rift Valley and is a natural extension of the Serengeti, which is situated in Tanzania. The Mara River, the spine of the park, crosses it from north to south, flowing into Lake Victoria. Each year this area is the scene of the great wildebeest migration, when a million species all move together in search of new pastures. But this is also the land of the Masai tribe, a very independent people who still believe in the traditions of their land and consider themselves to be part of the landscape which surrounds them. They are a nomadic tribe who were at one time much feared due to their nature as warriors and who actively contributed to the independence of Kenya.



**DAY 1:** Malindi (or MOMBASA)-MASAI MARA  
 An early morning flight to the Masai Mara reserve, flying over Mount Kilimanjaro, known as the Roof of Africa for its 5985 meters above sea level. A really spectacular flight over the savannah at low altitude, seeing herds of elephants and nearby landscapes. You will land directly in the savannah, after which you will take part in game drive until lunch. Which is held at the Siana Springs tent camp. Followed by evening game drive from afternoon until sunset. Dinner and overnight stay.

**DAY 2:** MASAI MARA An impressive Safari at dawn and return to camp for breakfast. The day is devoted to visiting various corners of the reserve, with lunch at the camp. Dinner and overnight stay at the same field.

**DAY 3:** MASAI MARA-Malindi (or MOMBASA) An evocative Safari at first light. Breakfast and Safari until lunch, which will be held at the camp. Early afternoon you will be transferred to the reserve’s airstrip, and return flight to the coast. Landing and end of the programme.
